HCZ MAINTAINS A 457(F) PLAN FOR CERTAIN ELIGIBLE EMPLOYEES OF THE SCHOOL. EMPLOYEES BECOME ELIGIBLE TO PARTICIPATE IN THIS PLAN BASED SOLELY AT THE DISCRETION OF THE SCHOOL'S BOARD OF TRUSTEES. THE AMOUNTS CONTRIBUTED WILL VEST IN EITHER THREE OR FIVE YEARS. HCZ PROVIDES THE SCHOOL WITH AN ANNUAL SUBSIDY TO COVER THIS COST BY CONTRIBUTING TO A HCZ INVESTMENT ACCOUNT. DURING FISCAL 2024, HCZ PROVIDED A SUBSIDY OF \$588,450. FOR THE FISCAL 2024 CONTRIBUTION TO THE 457(F) PLAN. IN ADDITION TO THE 457(F) PLAN SUBSIDY, THE ACADEMY ALSO RECEIVED ADDITIONAL GRANT FUNDING IN THE AMOUNT OF \$882,764 FROM THE HARLEM CHILDREN ZONE, (FOR A TOTAL CASH FUNDING OF \$1,471,214 FOR THE YEAR ENDING JUNE 30, 2024).
